- Recognise common number sequences
- Describe number patterns
- Find multiples and factors
- Work out the square numbers
- Use simple word formulae
- Use co-ordinates in the first quadrant (all positive)
- Multiply and divide whole numbers by 10 and 100
- Know my times tables up to 10x10
- Add, subtract and order decimals with one, two and three decimal places
- Check my own answers
- Use simple fractions and percentages
- Use written methods for addition, subtraction, multiplication and division (without a calculator)

- Make 3D models
- Draw 2D shapes in different directions
- Understand faces, edges and vertices
- Find perimeters of shapes
- Find the area by counting squares
- Reflect simple shapes in a mirror line
- Use rulers and other scales for measurement

- Draw and interpret line graphs and bar charts
- Present data clearly
- Read simple pie charts
- Collect & record data in tally charts & frequency tables
- Group data in equal class intervals
- Find and use the mode and the range
